

YEAR 7 ADMISSIONS – SEPTEMBER 2020

Frequently Asked Questions and Queries.

Q. I want my child to attend FHS but did not get offered a place?

A. We are oversubscribed and cannot offer any additional places.

Q. Can I place my child on the waiting list?

A. Yes but this has to be done via the City Council. The parent/guardian needs to contact the Admissions Team.

Q. I put FHS as my 1st choice and did not get a place.

A. We cannot offer any spaces but you can contact the Council if you would like to appeal.

Q. I have tried to contact the City Council but can't get an answer.

A. Unfortunately it is a busy time and getting through to Bristol City Council can take some time; you will need to keep trying.

Q. I have been offered a place in FHS. Can I get a school tour?

A. We do not offer school tours outside of our open events. All families who have been offered a place are invited to a Transition Evening on Thursday 2nd July, no booking required.

Q. When is Summer School taking place?

A. Week commencing 20th July 2020.

Q. How can I book a place on FHS Summer School?

A. Places for summer school are only available to those who have accepted their place of an offer at Fairfield High School. Please contact Jackie Kramer-Arden by emailing JKramer@fairfield.excalibur.org.uk

Q. Are Summer School places available for all students attending FHS in September?

A. Letters will be sent to families after 16th March. There are enough places for all students to attend.

Q. Is Summer School free?

A. Summer School will cost £50 without meals for the week and £60 with school meals provided for the week. Your child's primary school will be able to confirm if your child meets the Pupil Premium criteria. If they do, your child is entitled to a free place at Summer School with school meals included.
